

Confirmation of compliance with the Directive RoHS 2002/95/EC

Directive of the European Parliament on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Harmful Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment.


From 01.07.2006 the following harmful substance contents in new electrical and electronic equipment must not be exceeded.

• Lead (Pb)	0.1	% by wt.
• Cadmium (Cd)	0.01	% by wt.
• Mercury (Hg)	0.1	% by wt.
• Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)	0.1	% by wt.
• Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	0.1	% by wt.
• Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)	0.1	% by wt.

= < 4% mass percentage in Cu alloys permitted
= flameproofing agent containing bromine
